2020-2021 Financial Aid Eligibility for Preparatory Coursework

Students who are not admitted to a degree program are typically not eligible to receive federal financial aid. However, if students are enrolled in coursework specifically to meet prerequisites for admission to a degree program, they may be eligible to receive federal student loans for a period up to one year. To be eligible, the coursework must be required for admission. Taking courses to raise a GPA in order to be admitted does not qualify. Students seeking to enter an undergraduate degree program who qualify for this exception may borrow up to \$2,625 in federal loans, with up to \$6,000 more in unsubsidized loans for independent students or dependent students whose parent is denied the Parent PLUS Loan. Students seeking to enter a graduate degree program who qualify for this exception may borrow up to \$5,500, with up to \$7,000 more in unsubsidized loans for independent students.
